The Jean Shehee Grant was established by the Gamma Lambda Chapter of the National Sorority of Phi Delta Kappa, Inc. in 2009 in memory of Jean Shehee, retired Pasadena Unified School District Special Education Teacher. Jean was dedicated to her students and constantly sought resources that would enhance the classroom and learning experiences for this very special student population. This grant will be awarded annually to a PUSD Special Education teacher to provide additional classroom activities and experiences that enhance the learning, social development and general support of the PUSD students. There is a proposal application form that is required to be submitted.

GRANT AMOUNT

The Jean Shehee Grant is a maximum of \$1,000.00.

GRANT GUIDELINES

- The applicant must submit a proposal that demonstrates how the proposed activity will directly benefit students, enhance and enrich classroom learning and student development.
- The proposal must also include an itemized budget.
- Applicants must submit 1 original plus 2 copies of the proposal to the committee.
- Recipients are required to submit an evaluation report upon completion of the activity or project. Individuals who do not fulfill this requirement are ineligible for future grants.
- All grants must have principal's signature.
- Proposals will be reviewed by a committee established by Gamma Lambda and recommendations will be made to the membership of the the Chapter who has the sole discretion in the awarding of funds.
